2. Event

The **16th Int. Raiffeisen Oberösterreich Rundfahrt 2026** will take place from Thursday 4th of June 2026 to Sunday 7th of June 2026 over four stages covering a total distance of 517,8 km. The event is registered on the UCI Europe Tour as a class 2.2 event and is open to Men Elite and Men Under 23 riders. For the UCI Europe Tour ranking, the following points are awarded according to Art. 2.10.008 of the UCI Regulations:

General Classification:	40, 30, 25, 20, 15, 10, 5, 3, 3, 3
Stage Classification:	7, 3, 1
Leader of the General Classification:	1 (wearing the leader's jersey at each stage)

3. Regulations

This event is organised in accordance with the currently valid UCI Regulations and supplemented by the integrated special provisions. The UCI scale of penalties shall apply.

3.1 Anti-Doping:

Anti-doping controls will be carried out in accordance with the UCI Anti-Doping Regulations and the regulations of NADA Austria.

- 4th Stage: Schlägl Abbey Administrative Building - Schlägl Hauptstraße 5, 4160 Schlägl

4. Participation

In accordance with article 2.1.005 of the UCI Regulations, the event is open to invited UCI ProTeams from the organiser's country (Austria), a maximum of 2 foreign UCI ProTeams, UCI Continental Teams, UCI Cyclo-Cross Professional Teams, national teams, regional teams and club teams. Teams shall comprise a maximum of 6 riders and a minimum of 4 riders. (Art. 2.2.003 UCI Regulations).

6. Route Plan

The route plan is attached to these regulations in the form of time schedule tables. These indicate the start and finish locations, the start and finish times, as well as any possible obstacles to watch out for.

7. Classifications

7.1 Time Limit

The time limit for stages 2, 3 and 4 shall be 12% of the winner's time. For stage 1, the time limit is 50% of the winner's time. Under special circumstances, the time limit may be modified by the Commissaires Panel in agreement with the organiser.

7.2 Summit Finish

For stage 1, Art. 2.6.027 of the UCI Regulations shall not apply.

7.3 General Classification: (yellow jersey)

The General Classification is established by adding the times of all stages, taking into account time bonuses and time penalties.

In the event of a tie, the following criteria shall apply, in accordance with Art. 2.6.015 of the UCI Regulations, until the tie is broken:

- the lower total of placings obtained in the stages
- the best placing in the last scored stage

7.4 Time Bonuses:

For the overall Classification, the following time bonuses are awarded on all four stages for stage finishes and intermediate sprints:

- 1) for the first three riders on each stage: 10, 6 and 4 seconds
- 2) for the first three riders at each intermediate sprint: 3, 2 and 1 second

7.5 Points Classification: (blue jersey)

On each stage, the first eight riders in the stage result shall receive 20, 15, 11, 8, 6, 4, 2 and 1 points respectively. At each intermediate sprint listed in the time schedule table, the first three riders in the order of passage shall receive 4, 2 and 1 point.

The overall Points Classification is established by adding the points scored by each rider in stage finishes and intermediate sprints on the individual stages. In the event of a tie on points, the number of stage wins shall decide, followed by the number of intermediate sprint wins. If the tie still remains, the better placing in the individual General Classification after the most recently ridden stage shall decide.

7.6 Mountain Classification: (white jersey with red polka dots)

For **HC Mountain Classifications**, the first five riders in the order of arrival shall receive 10, 8, 6, 4 and 2 points. For **category 1** Mountain Classifications, the first five riders in the order of arrival shall receive 6, 4, 3, 2 and 1 points. For **category 2** Mountain Classifications, the first three riders in the order of arrival shall receive 5, 3 and 2 points. On stage 1, category 1 Mountain Classification points shall be awarded at the finish to the first five riders.

The overall Mountain Classification is established by adding the points scored by each rider on the individual Mountain Classifications. In the event of a tie on points, the number of Mountain Classifications won in the highest category shall decide. Then the number of first places in the next lower category shall decide, and so on. If the tie still remains, the better placing in the individual General Classification of the last ridden stage shall decide.

7.7 Best Young Rider: (white jersey)

This classification includes all Men Under 23 riders listed in the individual General Classification. Classification and ranking are based on the individual General Classification.

7.8 Team Classification

According to Art. 2.6.016 of the UCI Regulations, the stage Team Classification is established by adding the times of the three best riders within a team. In the event of equal times, the sum of the placings of the three best riders shall decide. If there is still a tie, the best-placed rider in the Stage Classification shall decide.

The overall Team Classification is established by adding the results of the individual stages. The Team Classification shall be used for the calculation. In the event of equal times, the number of first places in the daily Team Classification shall decide. If there is still a tie, the number of second places in the daily Team Classification shall decide, and so on. Any team with fewer than 3 riders shall be removed from the Team Classification.

7.9 Best Austrian Rider: (red jersey)

This classification includes all Austrian riders listed in the individual General Classification and ranking are based on the individual General Classification.

7.10 Leader Jerseys – Order of Priority

9. General Provisions

9.1 Participation and Conduct Rules

9.1.1 By participating in the race, each participant acknowledges these regulations without reservation and undertakes to comply with them.

The instructions of the emergency services and the officials must be strictly followed.

Only the instructions issued by the above-mentioned official functionaries are valid; all communications and provisions coming from any other side are null and void.

9.1.3 Each tour participant shall of course meet his or her personal financial obligations. The organiser accepts no financial liability of any kind whatsoever.

9.1.4 All tour participants are obliged to exercise the utmost caution.

Road traffic regulations must be followed and observed without exception. The Austrian Road Traffic Act (StVO) applies.

The organiser declines any responsibility for possible violations and their consequences. The entire accompanying convoy must drive with dipped headlights.

9.1.5 For all accredited tour escorts, stickers for all vehicles will be issued and must be affixed in a clearly visible position to the front and rear of the vehicle. Transfer of these official stickers is prohibited.

9.2 Guidelines for Riders

- 9.2.1** Teams must appear together to sign the start sheet, in accordance with the list of presentation times. The wearers of the leader's jerseys must be at the start line no later than 10 minutes before the start.
- 9.2.2** The first-placed rider of each stage as well as the wearers of the leader's jerseys are without exception obliged to make themselves available to the organisation management for the podium ceremony immediately after reaching the stage finish (within 10 minutes). **The organisation management also requests the first three riders of each stage to attend the podium ceremony.**
- 9.2.3** If riders are more than 10 minutes behind the main field on individual stages, they may be removed from the race by the race management for traffic-related reasons.

9.3 Guidelines for the Sports Directors

- 9.3.1** At the stage finish, vehicles must use the designated parking areas. Parking in the finishing straight and immediately beyond it is prohibited. Only the police, the race management, the vehicle of the organisation management, the race commissaires, the race doctor, the ambulance and the broom wagon may cross the finish line.
- 9.3.2** Each team receives the house and room keys at reception against a **deposit of € 100,-**. After complete return on the day of departure, the deposit will be refunded. Each team is responsible for any costs and liability arising from possible damages, missing keys, missing towels, occupancy by more than nine persons, etc.

9.4 Hygiene and Environmental Protection Guidelines

- 9.4.1** Riders, Sport Directors and officials are obliged to keep the start and finish areas clean and to avoid any damage to public or private property. Riders are reminded that discarding litter (materials that do not decompose) is prohibited along the entire race route, except in the designated areas at the feeding zone and before the 20-kilometre mark, where waste collection containers will be placed.
Urinating during the stage in towns or in view of spectators is prohibited.

9.5 Final Provisions

- 9.5.1** In the event of any differences in the interpretation of the rules, only the German text of these regulations shall be authoritative.
- 9.5.2** For all incidents or infringements not mentioned above, the Commissaires Panel shall decide finally.
- 9.5.3** The Commissaires Panel reserves the right to make changes if circumstances so require. Any such changes shall be communicated in due time to the Sports Directors and riders by bulletin via e-mail.
